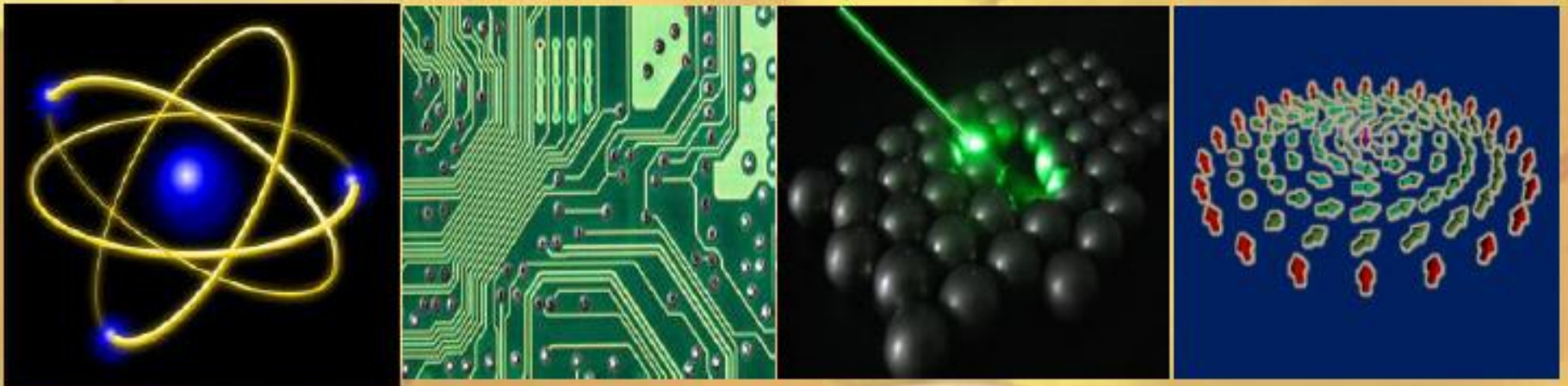


# **International Symposium on Present and Future of Material Sciences**

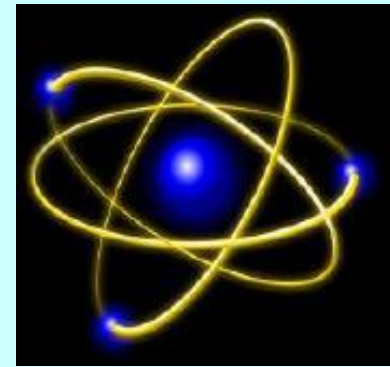
